Aarback Road Bridge Replacement Comment Card





MSA Professional Services, Inc. in conjunction with the Town of Albion and Wisconsin Department of Transportation are working on plans to replace the Aarback Road bridge over Koshkonong Creek, see enclosed project location map. The need for this project is to address the roadway safety, geometrics, and connectivity of the existing substandard and deteriorated structure over Koshkonong Creek. The existing bridge was built in 1954 and is badly deteriorated. The bridge is structurally deficient and shows signs of spalls, cracks, corrosion, and sections loss at the girders.

The project will consist of the reconstruction of the Aarback Road bridge to a two span haunched concrete slab bridge and roadway approach reconstruction. The horizontal and vertical alignment will be similar to existing. Total project length is approximately 187 feet. Right-of-way acquisition is anticipated for the project. The roadway will be closed during the duration of the project. Construction is scheduled for summer 2022.
